

ZFS Pools

Pools are the basic storage unit of ZFS. Whether the pool is a partition, a single drive, or some form of raid array, the pool is, at the same time, the entire storage space, and the root filesystem of the device.

Some [variables](#) are set, and locked during pool creation, and are not able to be modified after pool creation. This means that special care should be taken when crafting a pool, if you want those settings to be something other than the default.
