## **Removing files from smb share, 99% okay, 1% permission fail**

Hi,

I'm running a simple configuration freenas server and no problems till now.

I setup the server with almost no security. Just because my router will allow/deny all incoming users request except existing users (who are allowed to have all control possible)

Now i have anonymous selected for the smb-share and its going good so far.

Now i was trying to move some stuff from 1 disk to another because of write-speed disk to disk. And i cant delete some files.

I had 200GB of data on it, selected main folder and delete. Now 199,9 GB is deleted but for a few files i am not allowed to delete.

I cross-checked new files that i can delete and the ones i cant delete and there is no single difference when it comes too user/group permissions (i use ftp group because of anonymous login)

In the beginning i thought it was because of weird symbols in the dirname or filename, and maninly it is like that. But there are also some files in between who have normal dirs/filename that i cant delete.

Someone knows where to look or what i can do to delete those files??

PS. not an advanced user i am 😊

I did delete the files already with SSH, but i want a better way for me next time.
